Description <p>The system identifiers inserted in the DOCTYPE element of beta6 eml modules created by Morpho are not always meaningful or correct. Some point to urls on metacat, some just have a local file name which may or may not be available, and in some cases, the SystemId string is not a valid URL due to the fact that the catalog system was moved to inside of a jar file.</p> <p>This does not create a problem for Morpho since it uses public identifiers, but may be problematic for exported packages.</p>
