<b>Description</b> <p>Based on discussions with Eric Fegraus --- Currently, Project or Protocol modules can be added to a package but these modules are always associated directly with the top level dataset module. There is no way in Morpho to associate different Project/protocol modules with different entities (i.e. assign different protocols to different data sets (entities) all stored in the same package.) Eric had created a package with multiple entities and wanted to associate protocols with specific data sets.</p> <p>Note that in eml2, the method subtree has replaced protocol and method(s) can be placed directly under the dataset element and/or under the datatable entity. Project is only under the top dataset element, which is probably correct. (Entities in different projects should probably be described in differnt packages?)</p>
