<p>We need to upgrade to version 1.0.2 for vegbank.</p> <p>The model needs to be finalized (done: see Nov 21 version of db_model_vegbank.xml).</p> <p>The old data need to be migrated to the new version (mostly done: see src/sql in cvs for sql files that do this).</p> <p>Everything that breaks because of this change needs to be fixed. This can hardly be one bug.</p> <p>I quote from Gabe:</p> <p>-----</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1) Finalize 1.0.1 TO 1.0.2 vegbank conversion (almost there).2) Move Framework into vegbank 1.0.2 (hopefully nearly there).3) Get above working on development system and check (in progress).4) Create global script to package up all the steps.5) Upgrade vegbank server to postgres that can handle conversion. -> Need OS upgrade and postgres upgrade -> I like 7.4, testing the jdbc driver on my dev -> confirmed dump restore between versions works on 7.46) vegtest on vegbank conversion to v.1.0.17) Get code working on development with v1.0.28) Test out code modifications on vegtest on vegbank9) Vegbank on Vegbank ready for conversion <p>-----</p> <p>5) and 7) are a little tricky, I'm getting stuck in on 7) and hope to have a system that is functional for developing on ASAP. Some testing will be required to flush out all the mis-matches however.</p>
