Add a field search feature to the editor, e.g., if one wants to find the field containing the size of an external file, enter the keyword name (file size) into a search engine. This would be far superior to the current method of scrolling down through the Morpho Editor's tree control, looking for the desired field (which can take a long time and you may never find what you are looking for).

A search facility has been added which can search element names to see if they contain the entered search string. A editable combobox appears at the top of the tree with some common items in the list. If item is in the tree, it is selected and displayed.
