1) After clicking on the "NASA Global Change Master Directory (GCMD)" hyperlink, the page comes up in the same window, so when you close the window you actually close the data repository form you were working on, and the work you did is lost. The link should open up in a new window to avoid this blunder.

2) If the Data Repository Guide/Info Page is already open in a window because you clicked on a heading to read about it, and then you go back to the metadata entry form and click on another heading, the window with the Guide remains hidden behind the repository form window, instead of it coming to the front.
