Description

Instead of using the back button, there could be a button on the error page which does the same work as 'No, I want to edit the document' on the confirm page. I am assigning P1 to this as it would prevent a lot of effort for people using browsers which donot store value. Also it is useful in cases like dynamic taxon fields.
