Description

In Ldap, DN is not case sensitive. For example, uid=tao,o=nceas,dc=ecoinformatics,dc=org and uid=tao,o=NCEAS,dc=ecoinformatics,dc=org will be treated as same DN. But in metacat, they will be treated as two DN because in "o" phrase, one is "nceas" and the other is "NCEAS". In order to make Ldap and metacat consistent, we should make metacat non-case sensitive.

In PermissionControl and DBQuery class, the DN name in java code was transformed to lower case. In sql command, the field in db table which stores DN was changed to lower(fieldName). So both of them were changed to lower case, then compare them. This will make metacat non-case sensitive to DN.
