The date frame in the "define temporal coverage" dialog has two fields for year. One is read only and the other has two arrows to advance the year. I think the read only one could be dropped. When I clicked the "year only" radio in instinctively tried to edit the uneditable year field. it just seems unnecessary to have it there twice.
