#### Description

When the pathquery "returndoctype" filed is omitted, metacat is supposed to return all matching documents. In fact, no documents are returned under version 1.3.1, because it filters out all documents in the returndoctype listt is empty or null. Fixing this will require chaning the logic in the DBQuery module to include results even when the returndoctype field is not present.
