<b>Description</b> <p>Morpho buttons like the login button on the main screen or buttons on the tool bar don't show up sometimes. This problem is experienced by Jing most of the time. I think Matt also reported this for his Linux box. Andrea never noticed it but thats also the case in the screenshots taken for Morpho documentation.</p> <p>To reproduce the problem on a Win XP box - set the desktop theme to the default XP theme. Now run Morpho and you should be able to see the problem. I am not sure how to reproduce the problem on Linux - but desktop theme should be the culprit in that case also.</p> <p>So there might be some system calls made in the way borders are drawn for these buttons. And the color scheme returned for borders might be resulting in invisible borders.</p>
