Tested sending a data package with binary data file (image) to metacat, then deleting local package. This forces a download of the data from metacat. Resulting image was corrupted and could not be displayed.

Appears that problem is with Morpho's saving of metacat response to a file. Looks like filter for special xml-invalid characters is being (incorrectly) applied to data files! (Should only be used with XML files).
