<b>Description</b> Earlier versions of the SRB allowed any user to access and write to any SRB-registered storage resource. We need to be able to specify restrictions on the use of resources such that a particular site manager can indicate which users can write to the resource. This might be accomplished through a user/group ACL mechanism, or through srb domain capabilities, or otherwise.
