<b>Description</b> When importing a new data table in Morpho, if one imports a tab-delimited file it parses the file and allows metadata to be entered but does not display the data table correctly when finished. All of the data shows up in the first column, rather than in each column as it should. This bug was discovered in South Africa during a morpho training session.
