I tried for the ones I own. I deleted a bunch. Morpho won't delete some of them. It appears to be a bug, possibly related to the packages being beta6 packages. I was unable to delete the following packages:

In the process, i also noticed that only the most recent version of local packages are deleted (e.g., test.1.6), and the next time a search is done the previous version of the local package shows up (e.g., test.1.5). This repeats until test.1.1 is finally deleted locally.
