Description Users must wait for a search to be fully completed before being able to open a data package. This can take a long time, depending on the search parameters. It can be frustrating to have to wait for the search to be completed when the dp you want to open is already listed in the search results. It would be great to have a "Stop Search" feature, much like that provided when searching for an email in Outlook, or for a file on a computer.
