Description

When the " symbol is pasted in from an application like Word (which could occur when pasting in an abstract for example), the word in quotes is displayed as

&ldquoword&rdquo

instead of "word". This does not happen when the " symbols are typed in. This may be related to Bug 1516.

This bug has been fixed (base on callie's testing). Here are somethings i did:

- 1)Use ServletOutputStream to replace PrintWriter to send response of read and query actions. So Java wouldn't encode the special characters.
- 2)Fix a bug in normalize method in MetacatUtil class - it will encode special characters.
- 3)Fix a similar bug in normalize subroutine in register-dataset.cgi.
