#### Description

If a file exists in data/ then no data packages appear in the GUI.

#### ASSUMED SOLUTION:

The loop that iterates through directories in the local data/ dir needs to distinguish files from directories so that files can be skipped instead of breaking the loop.

A similar problem exists if there are any files in a subdirectory of data/ that don't conform to the pattern (in perl syntax) `.*?\.\d+/`

The most common way this seems to occur (unintentionally at least) is when Mac users open the .morpho directory in Finder and then move or delete files in data/ or its subdirectories. The OS creates ".DS\_Store" files in these directories. These files can safely be deleted if desired.
