<b>Description</b> When EML Datasources point to zipped data files, the data is supposed to be automatically unzipped when downloaded. This works OK when the zipped file directory is 'flat'; but when the zip file contains a hierarchy (e.g. has a top level dir 'topdir' which contains one or more other files), the automatic unzipping fails!
