Description

If the xsi:schemaLocation attribute of the eml element of a document is set improperly, no metadata (creator, coverage, table descriptions, etc) for the dp are shown. Removing the attribute altogether allows the dp to display properly. Morpho should be using the namespace rather than the schemaLocation to determine the type of the eml document.
