This bug could also be observed on a Linux machine. When searching "doc", the result tree will auto shrink to the top level. But when the user click through the tree hierarchy, it only displays those branches corresponding to the search results. Probably the tree view resets its focus and collapses its display. No other such kind of mysterious keyword was observed so far.
