Base documentation is provided by comments in java source code. In Kepler, adding any 'Custom Documentation' removes ALL the base documentation. In PTII, however, the custom documentation only replaces that fields where new info has been added.

The Kepler action of removing all base documentation is a 'bug' and should be corrected
