A right click on relations (vertexes) and connections does not bring up a popup menu. This is probably just a configuration issue since these do appear OK in Ptolemy.

The way to fix these is to run in vanilla Ptolemy, look at the menu and then run in Kepler and make sure that the translation in uiContextMenuMappings\_en\_US.Properties is correct.
