Description Modal Model (FSM) States can have Refinements (just as Transitions can have). The context menu for the Transitions contains a Look Inside item, while the one for the State does not. Note that after selecting the State, Ctrl+L opens the refinement. The issue here is that in Ptolemy, the transition menu choices are "Look Inside", not "Open Actor".
See bug [#2110](#) for "Look Inside" vs "Open Actor"
Transitions are not actors, so "Open Actor" is not correct.
States can be considered actors, though some (Edward?) may disagree.

See the StateTracker demo for a demo that has a transition that has a refinement.

This change is in both the devel trunk and the 1.0.0 release branch.
