#x0A <U000A> LINE FEED (LF) - This one is commonly used with recordDelimiter.

#x09 <U0009> CHARACTER TABULATION (HT) horizontal tabulation - This once is commonly used with fieldDelimiter

I think the comma delimiter is not a problem.
