#### Description

The display of inline data on the Metacat server strips out the line feed which can work as a record delimiter. This causes the data to display incorrectly and if someone copies from the page the line feed or record delimiter may be missing. Adding the

```
tag around the Inline data should fix this. Here is an example of a data set with Inline Data.
