Description

When uploading *data* files to Metacat, an attempt to use the application.tempDir is made. If that directory does not exist, an attempt is made to create it. Without proper permissions, this step fails and no data can be uploaded to the server. Setting up /var/metacat/* folders (data, inline-data, documents, temporary) may be the responsibility of the server admin rather than the Metacat configuration tool...
