<b>Description</b> Currently each project has a taxon collection excel spreadsheet that is generated by the person sorting through dead plants. It would be great if the entry tool could incorporate that into the tool itself, so that the list of taxa that were collected would be displayed (and sortable by plot, or other characteristic). Alternately, the entry tool could create the template of this information and port it into Excel.  If it remains in Access, then the updates that are made would automatically be part of the entry tool.
