<b>Description</b>			
When elements are repeated (eg the attribute element in eml-attribute) and subelements are repeated, it turns out that entering a text value for one element causes all the duplicate elements to have the same value!			

### History

It turns out that an attempt to speed up operation resulted in a single node to be assigned to multiple elements. In other words, the node was not cloned properly (actually the UserObject assigned to a treeNode was not cloned so that multiple treeNodes had the same userObject).

The fix was to add code to clone the userObject without having to make a deep clone of the entire treeNode and all its related nodes.
