Furthermore, the description.txt file is located in the root of the module instead of in the module-info directory where such metadata should probably reside.</p> <p>To close this bug:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">-The description.txt file needs to be redesigned to include the following fields (whoever works on this should evaluate and probably use the kepler documentation format for this):<ol style="list-style-type: none">1) Title2) Description3) Author*4) Related Modules*-The description.txt file should be located in module-info-All modules should have a valid description file and all core modules must have a description.txt file-Modify the list-modules task to print the description, name, etc of every module in the system.
