<b>Description</b>			
<p>It's easiest to describe this by documenting the steps to reproduce. This involves ESA, but I haven't checked whether it happens with non-public documents viewed using other registries.</p> <p>After logging into ESA, click My Submissions (or View Submissions if logged in as a moderator), then click to view any one of the listed documents. Note that these are all documents that are <b>not</b> publicly readable, but should be readable by the logged-in user. The Data Set Citation section near the top of the document contains a link that refers to the document itself, e.g.: <a href="http://esa-dev.nceas.ucsb.edu/esa/metacat/esa.65.3/esa">http://esa-dev.nceas.ucsb.edu/esa/metacat/esa.65.3/esa</a></p> <p>Clicking on the link produces an error:</p> <p>-----</p> <p>This XML file does not appear to have any style information associated with it.
