#### Description

On Figure 3.20 (page 66) of KeplerUserManual-2.1.0.doc, it shows how to reference a parameter OutputDir. It shows:

```
OutputDir+"ccov6190"
```

But it doesn't work in this way. It should be:

```
$OutputDir+"ccov6190"
```

A dollar sign is missed.
