how can we copy the new schema.xml to overwrite the existing /solr-home/conf/schema.xml?

Here is my thought:

- 1. During the configuration (installation), the hash of the existing schema.xml will be calculated.
- 2. If the hash value indicates that the schema.xml wasn't changed, the installation process will overwrite the existing one silently. I guess the possibility of the case will be more than 90%.
- 3. If the schema.xml was changed, we should show a message to ask the user manually merge the difference and put the new one into the place.
