For example, the link: <a href="https://knb.ecoinformatics.org/#data/query=&amp;fq=origin:*NCEAS*">https://knb.ecoinformatics.org/#data/query=&amp;fq=origin:*NCEAS*</a>			
is used to directly link to NCEAS data on the KNB. The current data search view will take the full query string (&fq=origin:*NCEAS*) and display it as a filter under the "all" filter textbox. It really should be displayed as an "*NCEAS*" or "NCEAS" filter under the "Creator" field. It will make more sense when users arrive at the data search page.
