Description Currently, morpho understands "gif", "jpeg", "jpg", and some other arbitrary format names. At a minimum, we need to also allow mime type designations (e.g., "image/gif"). As part of this, it would be nice if the data import wizard detected that the file being imported is an image so that it can skip meaningless screens of information such as "attribute" lists (which are currently shown).

Most users are unlikely to know what a 'mime-type' is. 'format' in the physical module in the wizard should thus be a choice element with choices meaningful to the user (and which insert mime types in the eml)

Also, I don't know of an easy way to detect image files (other than extenders). Need to find out if the first few bytes indicate file type.
