Description

If authoritativeMemberNode element is not set in the sysmeta submitted with an object during create() the MN doesn't set it, leading to the object or metadata not being able to be updated.

This is the case with

<https://mn-stage-ucsb-2.test.dataone.org/knb/d1/mn/v2/meta/urn:uuid:c8b42a90-7dd7-4dcc-a005-84a5cd26354c> , which can't be updated or have it's sysmeta updated. When this is attempted, the error is printed:
