It is cleaner to do it this way because even if there are no return fields, if the query is successful certain fields (from xml_documents) will be returned. Also, since each method is querying from a different table, combining the queries will make the functionality less clear in the code and may result in a less efficient query. We can revisit this at a later time if necessary.
